ASOCIACIÓN GIRASOL is now in its eleventh year!

We are going into our eleventh year of helping families and users. Completing and/or helping to bring their lives to a close in the best way possible. This year we took the initiative to add a new town to our working area, which is La Roda de Andalucia, in the province of Seville, where we have active volunteers and we hope to be able to expand our work there each year. Throughout 2022 we have attended to 45 users with their families, as well as 8 inicidental users whom we have been able to advise, and 24 patients continuing from last year with their families. In total we have helped about 140 people throughout 2022.

We continue to work from Monday to Friday, from 10-13.30 and also offer a telephone and What's App service on those 5 days. Our relationship with social groups (Town Halls, Health Centres, The Palliative Care team in the Hospital of Antequera etc) has been consolidated, communications have improved and we continue to improve and expand contact with other groups such as private companies.

As regards fund raising, our volunteers, as ever, continue to raise most of our funds. Without their dedication and commitment, Girasol could not continue to offer free disinterested help to so ,many families and users. In fact, at this moment is doing better than ever in the markets and at its events and we aim to continue working to expand into all the markets and towns that we can.





THE VAN

Everybody who knows Girasol knows that the van has been one of our greatest achievements. This year we want to acquire a ramp so that we can transport people who have motor skill problems, and make even more use of it.

We aim to install the ramp in the van in the near future, thanks to one private donation and we are looking for further funds to finance it.

NEW WORK ZONES

In 2022, we have added a new área to our established work zone: La Roda de Andalucía, province of Seville, where we are beginnign to make contact with local organisations. In addition, we are still doing work in the area of Antequera: Alameda, Fuente de Piedra, Humilladero, Mollina, Villanueva de Algaidas, Cuevas Bajas, Cuevas de San Marcos, Sierra de Yeguas, Bobadilla, Antequera, Archidona, Cartaojal y Campillos.

All the therapies and workshops which take place in the Day Centre are free and are run under the supervision of one of our professional team



PALLIATIVE CARE DAY

Every year, on International Palliative Care Day, Asociación Girasol organises a series of candle events in the towns where we work.

This event consists of people lighting a candle in memory of a loved one who is no longer with us or who is fighting a disease such as cancer. This year we were lucky enough to accompany the event with live music provided by Kate Perkes on violin and Jim Haig on keyboard.

This year we celebrated in Alameda, Fuente de Piedra, Humilladero, Mollina y Villanueva de Algaidas.

For the First time this year, we ran an information stall on Palliative Care Day in the Hospital of Antequera, where two of our professional team were available to give information about our work.

HELP AND ATTENTION OFFERED AND ASKED FOR

As we have said, we have been working in Girasol for 11 years now, attending to patients as well as their families and carers; We have assisted a total of 261 people with advanced or incurable illnesses

Among the help offered is the following:

Loan of Equipment Psychological Help

Transport Social Help

Care Assessment Physiotherapy

The Day Centre

All these services are offered free of charge, thanks to the professional team we have, which consists of a psychologist, a Social Worker, Nursing Help and

Administrative Help. Of course, we must not forget the vitally important work carried out by our British and Spanish volunteers.
